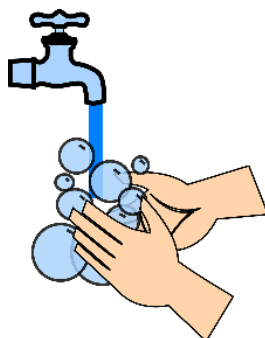

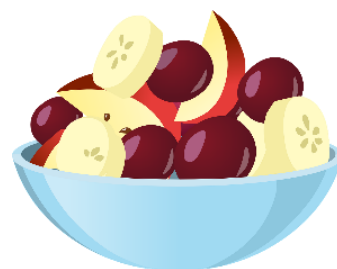

You should read books.



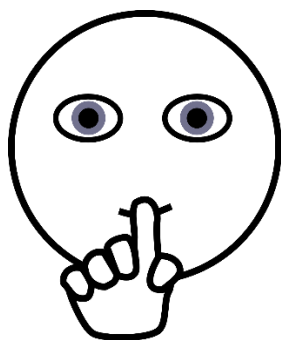
2. Powinieneś umyć ręce.
