2. We **will go** (go) a trip tomorrow if the weather **is** (be) sunny. **(1)**
3. I **will visit** (visit) you in Madrid next week if **have** (have) enough time. **(1)**
4. If we **had** (have) enough money, we **would buy** (buy) new furniture. **(2)**
5. If I **learn** (learn), I **need** (need) silence to focus. **(0)**
6. If you **forget** (forget) about my birthday again, I **will never speak** (never / speak) to you again. **(1)**
7. If Alice **married** (marry) Greg, she **would move** (move) to Boston with him. **(2)**
8. If they **invite** (invite) guests, they **prepare** (prepare) delicious meals. **(0)**
9. If I **eat** (eat) too much chocolate, I **will feel** (feel) sick. **(1)**
10. If I **were / was** (be) a teacher, I **would be** (be) very strict and demanding. **(2)**
11. What **would you do** (you / do) if you **were** (be) the president of Poland? **(2)**
12. Kate **will be** (be) happy if we **visit** (visit) her in the afternoon. **(1)**
13. I **would live** (live) in Spain if I **could** (can) choose a place to live. **(2)**
14. If I **was / were** (be) invisible, I **would sneak** (sneak) out of the school. **(2)**
15. If John **has** (have) a possibility to move abroad in the future, he **will go** (go) to France for good. **(1)**

**If you don't hurry up, we will be late.**
5. If Adam doesn't learn to speak English, he won't go to London next year.  
Unless **Adam learns to speak English, he won't go to London next year.**

**Zad. 3** Napisz zdania o poniższych sytuacjach używając zdania warunkowego typu drugiego (2nd Conditional).

1. I can't play basketball so I'm not in a school team. – **If I could play basketball, I would be in a school team.**
2. I don't have enough money to buy Xbox. – **If I had enough money, I would buy Xbox.**
3. Alice don't speak German. She can't work for BMW. – **If Alice spoke German, she would work for BMW.**
4. I don't have a good ear for music so I don't learn to play any musical instrument. – **If I had a good ear for music, I would learn to play a musical instrument.**
5. Adam can't cook so he won't invite his friends for dinner. – **If Adam could cook, he would invite his friends for dinner.**
6. We don't live in the mountains so we don't often go skiing. – **If we lived in the mountains, we would often go skiing.**
7. I don't know how to play badminton. I won't play with Peter and Luke tomorrow. – **If I knew how to play badminton, I would play with Peter and Luke tomorrow.**
