Ex. 1 Write phrasal verbs with the opposite meaning.

1. plug in ≠ **plug off**
2. get on ≠ **get off**
3. turn down ≠ **turn up**
4. switch on ≠ **switch off**
5. move in ≠ **move out**
6. get in ≠ **get out (of)**
7. put on ≠ **take off**
