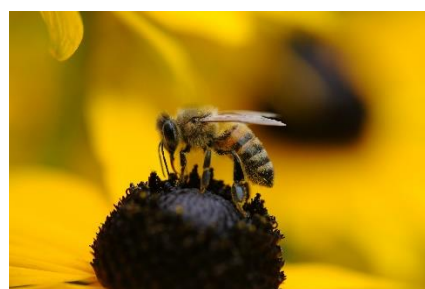
Zad. 1 Podpisz poniższe ilustracje w języku angielskim przedstawiające idiomy angielskie ze zwierzętami.



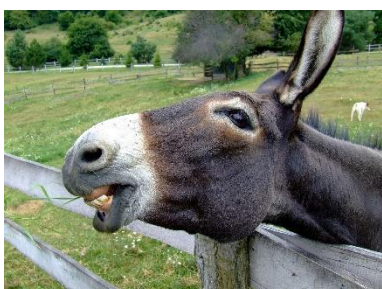
1. wesoty jak szczygieł –

as blind as a bat



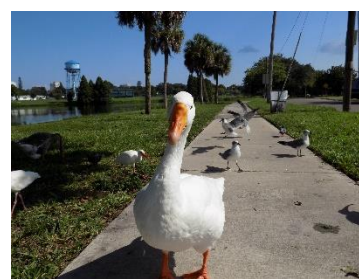
