5. Where did they meet for the first time? – **Do you know where they met for the first time?**
6. How much does he earn? – **Do you know how much he earns?**
7. Did they go bowling last weekend? – **Do you know if they went bowling last weekend?**
8. Why is Christina so angry today? – **Do you know why Christina is so angry today?**
9. Does Julie like her flatmate? – **Do you know if Julie likes her flatmate?**
10. How long have they been married? – **Do you know how long they have been married?**

I'd like to know **what Rita was wearing at Luke's birthday party.**
10. 'Where are my sunglasses?'  
Do you happen to know **where my sunglasses are?**

**WOULD**          I **would like to know how often you go** jogging.
5. Why are their children behaving so badly?  
**IDEA**             Do you have any idea **why their children are behaving** so badly?
6. Does she like seafood?  
**KNOW**            I don't **know if she likes** seafood.
7. How much did you pay for the tickets for a concert?  
**TELL**             Can **you tell me how much you paid for the tickets** for a concert?
8. Is it going to snow today?  
**IDEA**             Do **you have any idea if it is going to snow** today.
9. Why are your parents going to move to the countryside?  
**WONDER**        I **wonder why your parents are going to move** to the countryside.
10. What kind of job are you looking for?  
**WOULD**          I **would like to know what kind of job you are** looking for.
